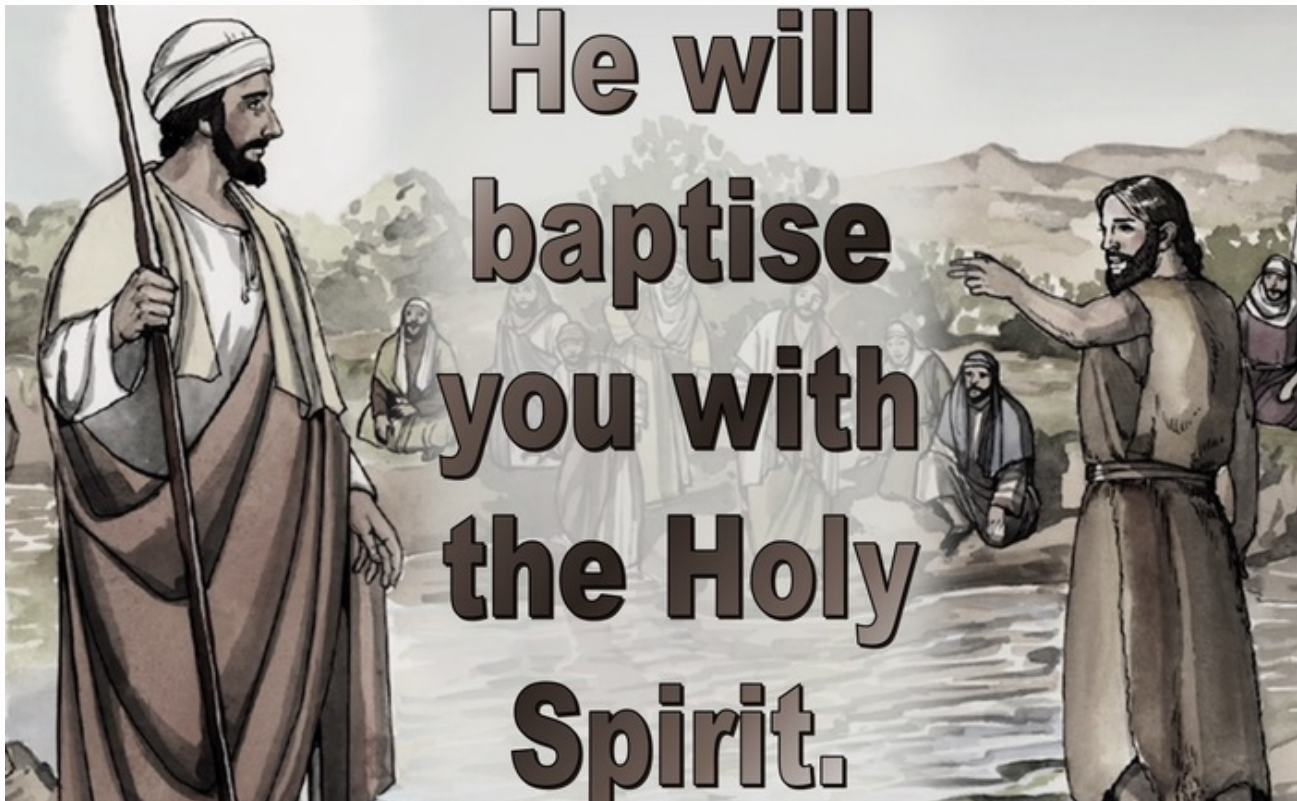

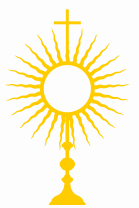

Nombra las personas que han sido ejemplos para ti de discipulado cristiano y describe las características que has tratado de emular. Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Marcos 1:1-8. Así como Juan el Bautista preparó el camino para Jesús, el Bautismo nos encarga preparar el camino del Señor. El don del Espíritu Santo nos lleva a renovar continuamente nuestras vidas para que podamos llevar a otros a Jesús. Como familia, identifiquen al menos una acción que tomarán esta semana para tratar de ser más fieles seguidores de Jesús. Concluyan juntos en oración para que Dios reciba esta acción y la use para llevar a otros a Jesús. Rezar la Oración al Espíritu Santo.

Background on the reading Gospel

In today's Gospel we hear John the Baptist contrast his baptism of repentance with the baptism that Jesus will inaugurate. John says that he has baptized with water, but that the one who is to come will baptize with the Holy Spirit. John's baptism was not yet a Christian baptism, but a preparation for the Sacrament of Baptism through which sins are forgiven and the gift of the Holy Spirit is received.

John the Baptist is presented to us as a model during Advent. We, too, are called upon to prepare a way for the Lord. Like John the Baptist, we are messengers in service to one who is greater than we are. Our Baptism commissions us to call others to life as disciples of Jesus.
