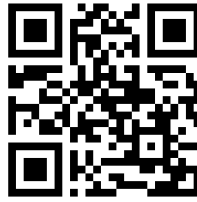

Conexion Familiar

En la vida familiar, aprendemos a confiar en otras personas para que nos protejan y cuiden. Esta experiencia de confianza dentro de la familia permite a los niños creernos cuando testificamos de nuestra fe en Jesús. Juan Bautista fue creído por quienes lo escucharon porque les ayudó a reconocer a Jesús entre ellos. En nuestra vida familiar, esperamos y oramos para guiarnos unos a otros a reconocer la presencia de Jesús en nuestro mundo. Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Juan 1:6-8,19-28. Discuta las señales de la presencia de Jesús en nuestro mundo que usted nombró y explique lo que estas señales nos dicen acerca de Dios y el amor de Dios por nosotros. Oren juntos para que su familia sea llevada a reconocer que Jesús está presente entre nosotros. Lean y oren juntos el salmo de la Misa de hoy, el Magnificat (Lucas 1:46-55).

Background on the reading Gospel

the Levites and the Pharisees question John about his identity and the meaning of the baptisms that he is performing. John's Gospel uses these questions to establish the relationship between Jesus and John the Baptist. John the Baptist is not the Messiah, nor is he Elijah or the Prophet. In John's denials, we hear echoes of the kind of messianic expectations that were common in first-century Palestine. The only affirmative response that John the Baptist gives is when he quotes the prophet Isaiah. Upon answering the next question, John announces that the savior they seek is already among them, but as yet unrecognized. John's response highlights for us an important Advent theme: Jesus has already come into the world as our savior. During Advent, we pray that we will be able to recognize Jesus' presence in our midst. Advent also reminds us that Jesus will come again to fulfill the promise of salvation. We pray that we will continue to be watchful as we anticipate that great day. The third Sunday of Advent is also called Gaudete Sunday. Gaudete, a Latin word which means "rejoice," is taken from the entrance antiphon for Sunday's Mass. This theme is echoed in today's second reading from the first Letter to the Thessalonians. It is a reminder that Advent is a season of joy because our salvation is already at hand.
